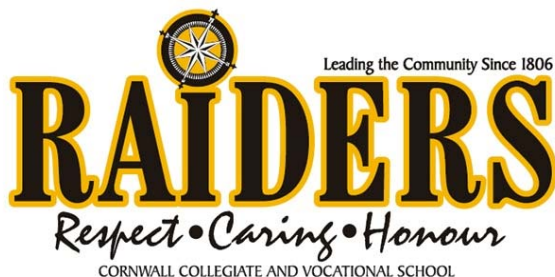

CCVS Renovations for 2011-12

Preparations and planning is well under way for the transformation of CCVS to a grade 7-12 school in September of 2011. Each of the grade 7 & 8 rooms in the Fifth St. wing are being totally renovated and will have new whiteboards, chalkboards, bulletin boards, a SMART board and new electrical work. Room 206 was completed in advance and looks great. This room was renovated sooner than others so that parents, guardians and students could see one of the rooms in its completed stage during the grade 6 & 7 Open house.

All of the washrooms in the building are to be renovated along with tiles being installed in most of the rooms with carpets. New locker doors are being planned for the Technology wing and the grade 7 & 8 wing.

When school starts in September students will only see Dell computers with LCD screens since all of the older computers are being replaced. A brand new set of iPod touches will be coming to CCVS with the students from GVIS as well as five SMART boards for the secondary area. The Fitness Centre is getting a new ½ inch thick rubber floor along with 15 spin bicycles and some new weight equipment.

There will be a number of other new things that will be happening at CCVS for next year, but we will save those for future newsletters.
